## **Suggestions for Abstract Writing**

The abstract or summary you submit for the conference needs to be clear and comprehensive, a maximum of 200 words in length, and it ought to address each of the following points. No more than 1 or 2 sentences should be required to address each of these points.

- 1. Clearly state what motivated your work (why did you do the work you did), that is, what makes your work interesting and relevant to a reader or conference attendant.
- 2. Clearly identify the specific question(s), issue(s) or problem(s) that are addressed by your work.
- 3. Identify the general approach or method you used for your work. Did you do an experiment, run focus groups, make observations while clients were engaged in a specific recreation activity, etc.?
- 4. Summarize the main results from your work, that is, describe what you learned or discovered by doing your work.
- 5. State the lesson(s), conclusion(s) or implications that can be drawn from your results.
- 6. Clearly identify the client or patient population with whom you worked or to whom your work is most directly relevant.
